Transportation to Nagoya

From overseas there are direct flights to Tokyo (Narita & Haneda), Nagoya and Osaka which are the top 3 cities in Japan.

If you arrive in Tokyo-Narita, the best way is to reach “Tokyo Station” by bus or train and then take the Shinkansen (bullet train) to “Nagoya Station”.

If you arrive in Tokyo-Haneda, the best way is to reach “Shinagawa Station” by train and then take the Shinkansen (bullet train) to “Nagoya Station”.

If you arrive in Osaka, the best way is to reach “Shi-osaka Station” by train and then take the Shinkansen (bullet train) to “Nagoya Station”.

If you arrive in Nagoya, take Nagoya Railroad (Meitetsu) to “Nagoya Station”.
